

Recreation Report to Acle Parish Council

1. We have now received our Covid -19 Business Interruption Claim. Unfortunately we have to uplift our sum insured which will have a knock on effect of increasing our premium.
2. We are continuing to progress with our grant application for solar panels at the centre. Emphasis3co2 have assisted up by paying for a full survey of the centre to establish our CO2 savings that would be achieved by installing solar panels. Fee of £1800.0 so we are hopeful with our application.
3. The new defib machine has now been installed and up and running, sited at the rear of the Recreation Centre on the back wall of the Memorial Garden.
4. We will currently be completing our programme of having all LED lighting installed in the Recreation Building hopefully by the end of this month the Yare Room will be the last to have LED fitted
5. The Tennis Club finally held their opening of the newly refurbished tennis courts on the 10th October. This was well attended with Alfe Hewit in attendance playing a few games with club members.
6. Indoor Bowls continue to go from strength in the new season. Acle indoor bowls has now the largest membership in Norfolk.49 new members at the last count.

The Club was represented at the National Championship Competitions, and we now have 2 new nation champions.

The Indoor Bowls have started a new Associate Membership scheme which will benefit both the Rec. Centre and the Social Club This initiative has been backed by the Norfolk Community Foundation with a donation of 1k .
