## ABOUT US

There are twelve councillors who work voluntarily for the good of the village. They all care very much about the village and its residents and are always thinking about how to make Acle an even better place to live and work.

Acle Parish Council looks after parts of the civil parish of Acle. We have three small play areas in Springfield, Damgate Lane and Beighton Road. The Recreation Centre also manage a play area, skateboard park and a zip wire. .

We also pay for grass cutting around the village and manage the cemetery in Pyebush Lane. The Parish Council has recently purchased new land at the top of Pyebush to provide an additional cemetery.

We have over 160 street lights in the village, Christmas lights, public toilets on the Street, benches, litter bins and bus shelters. The Parish Council also own the Fletcher Room, a community building on Fletcher Way which is mainly hired by Acle Pre School.

## MORE ABOUT OUR PROJECTS

### THE CHOCOLATE BOX

We are renovating The Chocolate Box building on The Street which is normally occupied by the newsagents and pet store and Acle Foodbank. The offices will be refurbished to hire for commercial and community use.

### OLD BARCLAYS BUILDING

We will be renovating the old Barclays building into 3 commercial units. We have already had expressions of interests from local businesses and look forward to providing more local retail opportunities for residents.



## PROTECTING OUR VILLAGE

Acle is a pro-active conservation area with its Site of Special Scientific Interest, it is home to many rare species, long natural walks, controlled Carr, rare marshes and unspoilt habitats all of which are ideal for lovers of nature, bird watchers and environmentally friendly groups of all ages.

The Parish Council is currently working with community groups at the planting of a native hedgerow, tress and wildflowers at the new cemetery.
